INCLUDE THEM IN YOUR FAMILY SAFETY PLAN

- ✓ Create their own Emergency Disaster Kit
- ✓ Make sure they are wearing tags with contact information and microchipped
- ✓ Practice taking your pets with you during an emergency
- ✓ If you are going to be gone, arrange care for them in advance

PREVENTION TIPS FOR YOUR PETS

Don't leave flames unattended (candles, fireplace, grill, etc.)

Pet proof your home by removing hazards and loose wires

Secure young pets in crates when you leave for short periods of time

Ensure stove knobs are in the OFF position or locked
